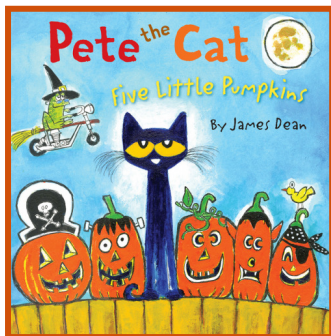

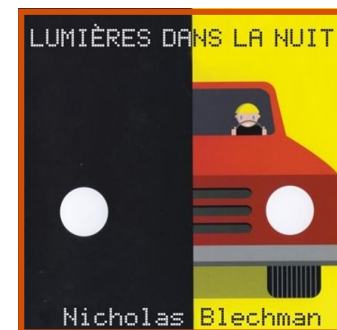

Questions

Inference

Question: *How does he know it's late?*

Reference: p. 6 "... it's getting late."

Micro-selection/Integration

Question: *Why do the bird and the cat have shoes in their feet?*

Reference: p. 16 "Let's run and run and run."

Vocabulary

Question: *What does "trick or treat" mean?*

Reference: p. 20 "I'm ready for some fun."

Elaboration

Question: *Did you like this story? Why?*

Reference: end of the book.
