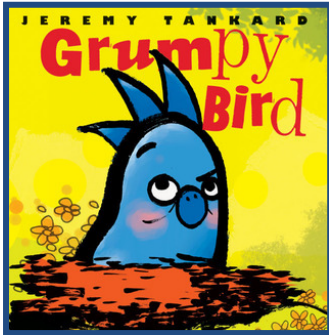

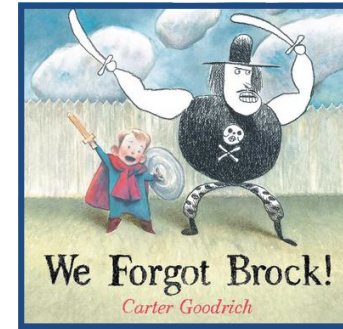

Inference

Question: *What will happen to Brock?*

Inference

Reference: p. 23 "... this is fun!"

Elaboration

Question: *Are you grumpy sometimes? Can you tell me in which circumstances?*
Reference: end of the book.
